Key Job Functions

- Leads in daily cabin Bible study, prayer, and chapel breakout discussions.
- Helps campers build meaningful relationships with others and assist those with social or emotional challenges.
- Presents provided educational materials to campers to help them understand God's Word.
- Facilitates activities that Geneva Hills offers alongside "Flex Crew"
- Responsible for providing leadership and direction for assigned campers so that they may participate in all activities and educational opportunities planned each day.
- Is firm in behavior management skills, never partial, always trying to be fair to all campers.
- Be an innovative problem solver seeking to improve the camper offerings of Geneva Hills.
- Be a spiritual leader and an example to all campers at camp.
- Gives any report, written or verbal, that may be required by the Ministry Director or Executive Director.

Other Duties
